"MEET" THE HACKER.

Introduce a mysterious hacker character leading up to the event (could be via emails or intranet posts). This character could send cryptic messages, challenge participants with mini-puzzles, or taunt teams with clues about the escape room. Think of it as a "cyber villain" they need to outwit!

Example puzzles:

- Encrypt a message in morse code and ask them to decode it.
- Create a fake Twitter profile (or use ours below) for the hacker and leak information on it ask people to OSINT them to find out the answer to a question about the escape room or about cyber security in general.
- A mini quiz about cyber security, famous cyber criminals, or hacker movies.
